| Red Gold  | - | Large fruit, sweet flavour. Deep red skin with gold blush and yellow flesh that separates easily from stone. Dessert and bottling. Late season. |

| Lusia                | - | S/F. Large yellow skinned, amazingly sweet and juicy. Heavy cropper. A winner               |
| Reine claud de Bavay |   |   |
|                      | - | S/F European greengage, crops heavily. Rich flavoured fruit. Late season                    |
| Santa Rosa           | - | S/F. Excellent flavour. Early to mid-seasoned with yellow, tinged pink, juicy, tangy flesh. |

Plumcot/Spring Satin	Upright, spreading tree bearing fruit that are a cross between a plum and an apricot. Has the smell of an apricot and the flavour of a plum. Delicious eaten fresh or used for jam. Ripens February.

| Harold Red Delicious |   |  |
|                      | - | NZ selection of the popular 'Red Delicious'. The skin is a very deep red colour and the aromatic, juicy flesh is coloured cream. Ripens in autumn. |
| Monty's Surprise     | - | Crisp, good eating late ripening apple that is good for cooking. Fruit is shiny red over light green background.                                   |
| Peasgood             |   |  |
| Nonsuch              | - | Very large, juicy apple. Semi dwarf. Cooks to a sweet delicately flavoured puree. Good disease resistance. Mid-season. Heritage.                   |

Conference SF /Doy-du-Comice

- Conference is a medium to large pear, with green,russeted, fairly smooth skin. The sweet, juicy, melting flesh is rich and aromatic. Doy du Comice is,green skinned flushed red with white, melting juicy flesh of rich flavour. Tastes like sweetened cinnamon. Mid to late season

Conference SF/Red Bartlett

- Conference is a medium to large pear, with green,russeted, fairly smooth skin. The sweet, juicy, melting flesh is rich and aromatic.
- Red Bartlett produces pears with bright-red skin when fully ripe. The fruit is very aromatic and has a melty flesh with good flavour
