

Do you have Thrips attacking your garden?

Extremely active, thrips feed in large groups with numbers increasing as temperature warm up. As a precaution, spray in spring.

They leap or fly away when disturbed. Host plants include onions, beans, carrots, squash and many other garden vegetables, and many flowers, especially gladioli and roses.

Thrips damage plants by sucking their juices and scraping at fruits, flowers and leaves. Plant leaves may turn pale, splotchy, and silvery, then die. Injured plants are twisted, discoloured and scarred.
